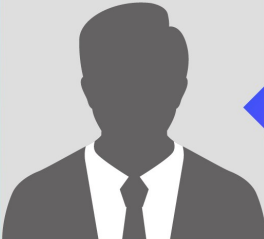


IDRS PLATFORM
